The film was made in 1979, however, there had been a television series for a number of years before. Some of the actors from the TV series were in that first movie. It tells the story of the USS Enterprise in the 23rd century – sent on a 5 year mission to “explore new worlds and boldly go where no one has gone before” – a phrase now used in every episode/film.

In all of the series and movies, the major characters have stayed the same – different actors playing them. The clothes worn at those times, 60’s and 70’s look strange to me and in the later series/films the fashion changes to the present day in the latest movie, Star Trek Beyond 2016.

There was less technology than there is now and the early series and films looks very basic, with poor computer images.

How have attitudes changed since the 60's and 70s

The 60's and 70's genre seemed like people were less stressed and more relaxed than today. Our fashion today is better, I would not like to have worn flowered bright coloured flared trousers!

The 60s was known as the "swinging 60s" with music, fashion and films becoming more popular. It ended with the first man landing on the moon. In 1966 England won the World Cup

The 70s brought strikes – postmen, dustmen and miners. People could watch TV in colour for the first time and money changed from shillings and pence to pounds and pence.

Generally women stayed at home and looked after the children whereas now women have successful careers and men sometimes stay at home or work part time; tasks are shared more equally. In 1979 England had its first every female prime minister.

Supermarkets opened and you could buy all your food in one shop. We now order on line and have the food delivered to our doors.

It feels like everyone is so busy now that things have had to change to fit around busy people. Convenience is very important and allows families to have the things they want when they want them.

What have I learnt:
