

Engaging Question: How do natural disasters shape our world?

Key Knowledge

Natural Disasters Overview:

- **Earthquakes:** Sudden shaking of the ground caused by the movement of tectonic plates. Can lead to building collapses, tsunamis, and landslides.
- **Tsunamis:** Large ocean waves usually caused by underwater earthquakes or volcanic eruptions. Can flood coastal areas and cause significant damage.
- **Hurricanes:** Powerful storms with strong winds and heavy rain, forming over warm ocean waters. Can cause flooding, wind damage, and storm surges.
- **Wildfires:** Uncontrolled fires that spread rapidly through vegetation. Can destroy homes, wildlife habitats, and lead to air pollution.

Causes and Effects:

- **Causes:** Natural disasters are often caused by natural processes such as tectonic plate movements, weather patterns, and human activities like deforestation.
