We are pleased to offer an exciting opportunity for students to attend a live football fixture between **Wolverhampton Wanderers U21s and Leicester City U21s** on **Friday 3 October**. The match will take place at the **Aggborough Stadium**, home of **Kidderminster Harriers**.

This is a fantastic chance for students to watch some of the country's rising football talents, including potential first-team players working towards match fitness. We expect this to be a highly competitive and enjoyable evening for all involved.

Trip Details:

- **Date:** Friday 3 October 2025
- **Meeting Point:** Cradley Heath train station
- **Meeting Time:** 5:55pm
- **Train Departure:** 6:09pm to Kidderminster
- **Kick-Off Time:** 7:00pm
- **Return Train:** 9:07pm, arriving back at Cradley Heath for approximately 9:22pm
- **Collection Point:** Cradley Heath train station (Students need to make their own way home from the train station)

Additional Information:

- The total cost of the trip is **£4**, which covers **train travel and match entry**.
- Payment will open via **Arbor Pay at 6:00pm on Wednesday 24 September**
- Spaces are **strictly limited**, but we hope to offer similar opportunities later in the year
- Please note **refunds will only be possible if cancellation is confirmed by Friday 26 September** due to ticket booking and risk assessment completion

Food & Drink:

- Students may have the option to purchase snacks at or near the ground (please note many vendors are **cashless**)
- We encourage students to bring their own **snacks and drinks**, but **bottle tops will be removed at entry** as per stadium policy

Medical Information:

- Students who carry emergency medication (e.g. inhalers, EpiPens) **must have it with them** on the trip
- Unfortunately any student without their required medication **will not be permitted to attend** for health and safety reasons

We understand that financial circumstances may make it difficult for some families to participate. If this is the case and you would like your child to attend, please do not hesitate to contact the academy in confidence so we can explore ways to support you.

We consider a student's behaviour, attitude to learning and attendance when offering off-site experiences. We expect all students to uphold the Academy's standards and expectations both before and during trips.
