Year 8 Residential
PGL Boreatton Park
Wednesday 3 June – Friday 5 June 2026

We are organising a residential trip for our Year 8 students to PGL Boreatton Park, Shrewsbury, taking place from Wednesday 3 June until Friday 5 June 2026. This exciting opportunity will allow students to develop confidence, resilience and teamwork skills, while taking part in a wide range of outdoor activities. Activities will be led by trained PGL staff.

We have 80 spaces available which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. To secure a place on the trip we require a £50 non-refundable deposit, payable via Arbor, by Friday 20 March 2026.

If cost is a barrier, we encourage students to apply to the Tyrese Johnson Foundation Fund for support. In order to make an application students should e-mail Ms Jones (njones@tca.shirelandcat.net) explaining why they want to be involved and what they hope to gain from the experience.

Trip Details:

- Accommodation: Students will be staying in small groups in tents onsite; staff tents will be located in the same area
- Total cost: £160.00, the cost includes all meals, activities and return travel by coach
- Students will be supervised at all times by staff

This promises to be a memorable and rewarding experience for our Year 8 students.

We consider a student's behaviour, attitude to learning and attendance when offering off-site experiences. We expect all students to uphold the academy's standards and expectations both before and during trips, places maybe rescinded if academy standards are not met.

In preparation for this, all families will be expected to confirm that they have checked the contact details for their child within the Arbor Parent Portal, as these details will be used by staff throughout the event. If you require assistance in updating your child's details on Arbor, please contact reception.

Please contact the academy if you feel that financial constraints will be a barrier to your child participating. We will try and support in whatever way we can.
