

Dear Family,

Early Closure – Wednesday 24 June 2026

Following a review of the weather forecast and conditions within the academy, we have taken the decision to implement an early closure at 12.45pm on Wednesday 24 June.

We have worked hard to maintain normal operations and ensure that learning continues for as much of the day as possible. However, forecasts indicate that temperatures will continue to rise throughout the afternoon and, after carefully considering the wellbeing of our students and staff, we believe that an early finish is the most appropriate course of action.

Students will follow their normal timetable during the morning. We ask that families make arrangements for their child to be collected or to travel home safely from 12.45pm.

We will provide students in Year 8, 9 and 10 who are in receipt of free school meals with the opportunity to buy a more substantial snack at break time. Students in Year 7 in receipt of free school meals will be able to collect a grab bag from Lunch and Brunch at 12.45 as they leave the academy.

Students will still be able to wear academy PE kit. **Please ensure that your child attends the academy with a refillable bottle to ensure they stay hydrated.**

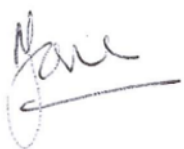
We will continue to monitor the forecast for Thursday and will communicate any further updates as soon as possible.
